Description: No background or prior training is needed for this workshop. The goal of the workshop is to introduce undergraduate students to some of the first principles and concepts from data analysis. Students who complete the workshop will have learned several technologies for data analysis, including skills for data wrangling and data visualization. The activities will enable students to dive into their first projects in data analysis, and to develop a sense of comfort and confidence with the computational tools.

We will discuss how to utilize R, and several related concepts for data analysis, but we emphasize that NO background with any of these tools is necessary to attend the workshop.
